iPad User Agreement, Acceptable Use Policy and Pledge for iPad Use 2017 - 2018

St. Paul's Catholic School leases Apple iPads for student use. Middle school students will be issued an iPad with predetermined Apps installed. Students and parents must read this agreement and sign the iPad use policy. The iPad will be used by the student according to the guidelines set forth in the document. St. Paul's retains the right to collect and inspect the iPad at anytime.

1. I will use my iPad in ways that are appropriate, educational, and comply with the requirements of the St. Paul's Catholic School Technology User Agreement, both at school and off campus.
2. I understand that my iPad is monitored and is subject to inspection at any time without notice and remains the property of St. Paul's Catholic School.
3. I will not take pictures or videos of anyone on our school campus without their explicit permission **and** for educational purposes only. This includes the use of personal cell phones.
4. I will use appropriate language when using emails, blogs, or any other form of communication.
5. I will only use social media games (internet games with communication) in the classroom, with teacher's instruction.
6. I understand all downloads (apps, music, games, etc) will be completed through the technology department.
7. I will protect my iPad and not remove it from the school-issued case.
8. I will not damage the iPad case (including any ripping or picking at the rubber barrier or home button cover).
9. I will not place stickers or marks of any kind on my iPad or cover, or deface the serial number sticker.
10. I will never leave my iPad unattended.
 - a. iPads found unattended will be returned to Ms. Thomas and incur a \$10 fee.
11. I will not loan out my iPad or share my password with others.
12. I will charge my battery each night and have it with me at all times (exception: cafeteria and recess)
 - a. Students will be charged \$1 to charge their iPad in the HUB if brought to school without sufficient power.
13. I will keep food and beverages away from my iPad at all times.
14. I will not disassemble or attempt to repair my iPad.
15. I will immediately report any vandalism or theft of my iPad.
16. I will be responsible for all damage and loss caused by neglect or abuse.
17. I will abide by each teacher's policy and rules regarding iPad use in their particular classroom.
18. I will return the iPad, case, power cord, and power adapter in good working condition at the end of the school year.
 - a. Cases deemed damaged and unusable will incur a \$25.00 fee.
 - b. Lost/damaged power cords and/or adapter will incur a \$20 fee, each.
19. I will not enable private mode for the internet or delete my browsing history.
20. I will update my iPad when a new iOS update is released by Apple.
 - a. If prompted, I will enter the PROXY username (student1) and password (learn) and never hit "cancel".

User Agreement

I hereby release St. Paul's Catholic School and its personnel from any claims and damages of any nature arising from my use of, or inability to use, the school technology; including, but not limited to, claims that may arise from the unauthorized use of the iPad to purchase products or services.

I understand that it is impossible for SPCS to restrict access to all controversial materials, although every effort is made to do so through the school server. I will not hold the school responsible for materials accessed via the internet on the school's network. I also agree to report any inappropriate iPad use to the school administration.

I understand violation of the technology agreement will result in disciplinary action. If the violation of policy requires any correction or repair to the device, a \$50.00 service fee will incur. Repairs not covered under the iCare Plan will be assessed to the student. All repairs must be completed through the SPCS technology department. In the case of loss or theft, students are responsible for the full replacement cost of the device.

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I accept full responsibility of technology when not in the school setting and understand that I am subject to the same rules, agreements, and consequences when off school property. I have read and understand the information contained in this document and agree to abide by the rules set forth.
